



New Personal Member Checklist

We are so pleased that you have made the choice to join Lake View Credit Union. Our commitment is to exceed your member service expectations, and be your partner as you define your financial future.

Following is a checklist to help you gather the items we'll need to complete your membership application:

Equity Shares

When you become a member with Lake View Credit Union, you also become an owner. Each member must purchase their individual equity shares when they join. Equity shares for adults are \$25.00, and \$5.00 for minors age 18 and younger.

Identification Requirements

Lake View Credit Union requires two pieces of valid identification for each member; one primary and one secondary. All ID presented must be current and unexpired. Below are common examples of each type of ID:

Acceptable Primary Identification:

Passport
Driver's License
Provincial ID Card
BC Services Card (with photo)
Permanent Resident Card
Secure Certificate of Indian Status

Acceptable Secondary Identification:

Birth Certificate
Credit Card
Certificate of Indian Status

If you are unable to provide these identification requirements, please talk to a service representative at any of our locations to discuss additional options. Foreign ID (issued by a government outside of Canada) may be used if it is equivalent to an acceptable type of Canadian ID and meets legal requirements.

Minors must provide a birth certificate and provincial health care card. A minor under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Social Insurance Number

All members aged 19 and over, must provide their social insurance number. Minors should provide their social insurance number if they have one.
